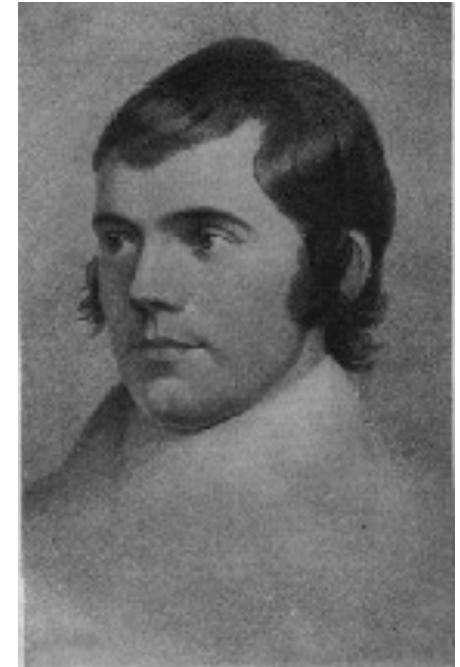
Directions to Jameson Inn and/or Lakewood Country Club will be sent on request.
