WHAT ARE WE LOOKING FOR? Anything depicting KIRKS AND PUBS OF SCOTLAND from both **professional** and **non-professional** artists! You're welcome to submit framed 2D artwork (oil, acrylic, watercolor, charcoal, pastel, graphite, photography, etc.) no larger than 32 inches in either dimension. It must not extend from the wall more than 3 inches. *You must indicate the name of the Kirk or Pub and location, as part of our educational outreach.* This will be a JURIED SHOW that will be on exhibit inside The Celtic Cup during April, including artist recognition during the...

HOW DO YOU SUBMIT YOUR WORK? Each artist may submit up to three works of art. Email 1-3 high-quality digital images (2MB or less each) of each submission to us at TheCelticCup@lighttube.net No later than **25 March**

WHAT IS THE DEADLINE FOR SUBMISSION? Digital images by **25 March**! Notification of jury selection will be sent to you via email on 27 March. Jury judging will be based on quality, creativity, originality and *adherence to the overall theme... Gathering Places of Scotland; Kirks & Pubs!*

WHAT IS YOUR SUBMISSION FEE? The submission fee is \$5 per entry. We're here to support you and give you a place to exhibit your work, but there are some expenses involved in this type of exhibit. You can pay by credit card over the phone, or with cash or card in person at The Celtic Cup. Please ask for Denise.

WHAT ARE YOUR EXHIBIT REQUIREMENTS? If you're selected for the exhibit, your finished work must be delivered to The Celtic Cup between 7am & 2pm, Friday 31 March or 7am–5pm Saturday 1 April. All work must be clean and free of offensive (non art medium) odors and wired, ready for hanging. Please label the back of your work with your name, title of your artwork, ***location and name of castle***, medium, dimensions, and price. We reserve the right to refuse any final work for display at time of delivery. All works will be hung on 2 April for the exhibit opening 3 April. The show will remain up through Saturday, April 29th (pick up will be Sunday 30 April, 1-3pm, 7-8pm, Monday 1 May 7am – 5pm).
