December 21, 2021, Exec Board MEETING MINUTES

Vice President presided, in the absence of the President Rita Christensen, Vice President Mark Smith presided. He called the meeting to order at 6:02pm. There were 11 members present. No minutes were accepted as the previous secretary and new secretary Pat Curley had not yet met to exchange them.

Carol Goodman, Co-Treasurer reported the bank balance as \$19,804.48.

Membership Co-Chair: Denise Smith thanked those present for attending. She then brought up the Burns Dinner, which will be at St. Barnabas on January 29, 2022. The Burns Dinner Committee is still working on the program for the dinner. The "Toast People" still need to be confirmed for the presenting of the Haggis, etc. Denise is still working on the menu and staffing. 25th Anniversary – *Jacobite by Name* will present the program.

Piping on The Green committee member Denise reminded us of the date of April 23, 2022. It was mentioned that we have cancelled advertising money from last year and that Rene' Cavett would need to get in touch with Lucky Knott manager or Pete Bowman from Bowman Media to work out the advertising time that needs reimbursement.

Bill Madewell, Historian is still gathering names of past members; please share the names you can remember.

Society is still in need of following positions: Ways & Means, Auditor, & Registered Agent.

Heritage Scholarship was brought up by Denise who mentioned that the Silent Auction at the Burns Dinner funds this, and we need items for auction still.

Denise as Convener reported that The Celtic Cup has chosen not to sponsor the **Smoky Mtn Games** so we could focus on our sponsorship/resources on the **Middle Tennessee Games** as they are closer to home, and we get a more positive response there. There is still no word about the Glasgow, KY, games due to ongoing issues there.

OLD BUSINESS: Executive Board voted unanimously to give Charter Members of the Society free membership from this point forward.

NEW BUSINESS: Alan mentioned that Facebook and emails need to be updated and sent out to membership for future meetings. Carol made a motion to compensate Celtic Cup \$50 per meeting for the use of space and staffing that is required, which received unanimous approval.

Randal Cunningham proposed re-instating membership cards, which has fallen by the wayside. **Denise** can contact vector graphics for said cards.

Famous Scots Dinner, brought up by Denise, will be held in September, date yet to be decided. Carol motioned that the first be in honor of *Robert Louis Stevenson*. A poll of membership will be taken to help decide on the change and results brought to the January Society meeting.


